



CARBON TAX IMPACT

INCREASE EFFECTIVE APRIL 1, 2022

The carbon price increased to **C\$50 per tonne of carbon dioxide (CO₂) equivalent greenhouse gas emissions** in April 2022.

These rates are prescribed by the Government of Canada on an increasing scale and are scheduled to increase to **\$65 per tonne in April 2023**.

Natural Gas Utilities are required to charge these rates as per the federal Greenhouse Gas Pollution Pricing Act. All fees charged under this Act are remitted directly to Revenue Canada.

On April 1, 2022 this charge increased to **\$2.63/GJ**

The new rate was automatically applied to your bill for natural gas consumed beginning April 1, 2022.
