## Friendly Reminders

Know the signs of natural gas leak; rotten egg smell, hissing sound, bubbling water or blowing dirt. **Contact the G.L.D.C. Gas office 24/7 at 403-843-1050**

Have your AC units serviced and filters replaced to avoid overworking the units.

We are now in warmer weather, remember to adjust in-floor heat, and thermostats in homes and garages.

Ensure smoke detectors and Carbon Monoxide detectors are current and up-to-date; check expiry dates and replace batteries if necessary.

Deep clean outdoor grills, check the fuel line for cracks and clean out clogged burners.

Private lines installed by you or a contractor are not included in a utility locate and will require a separate private locate.
