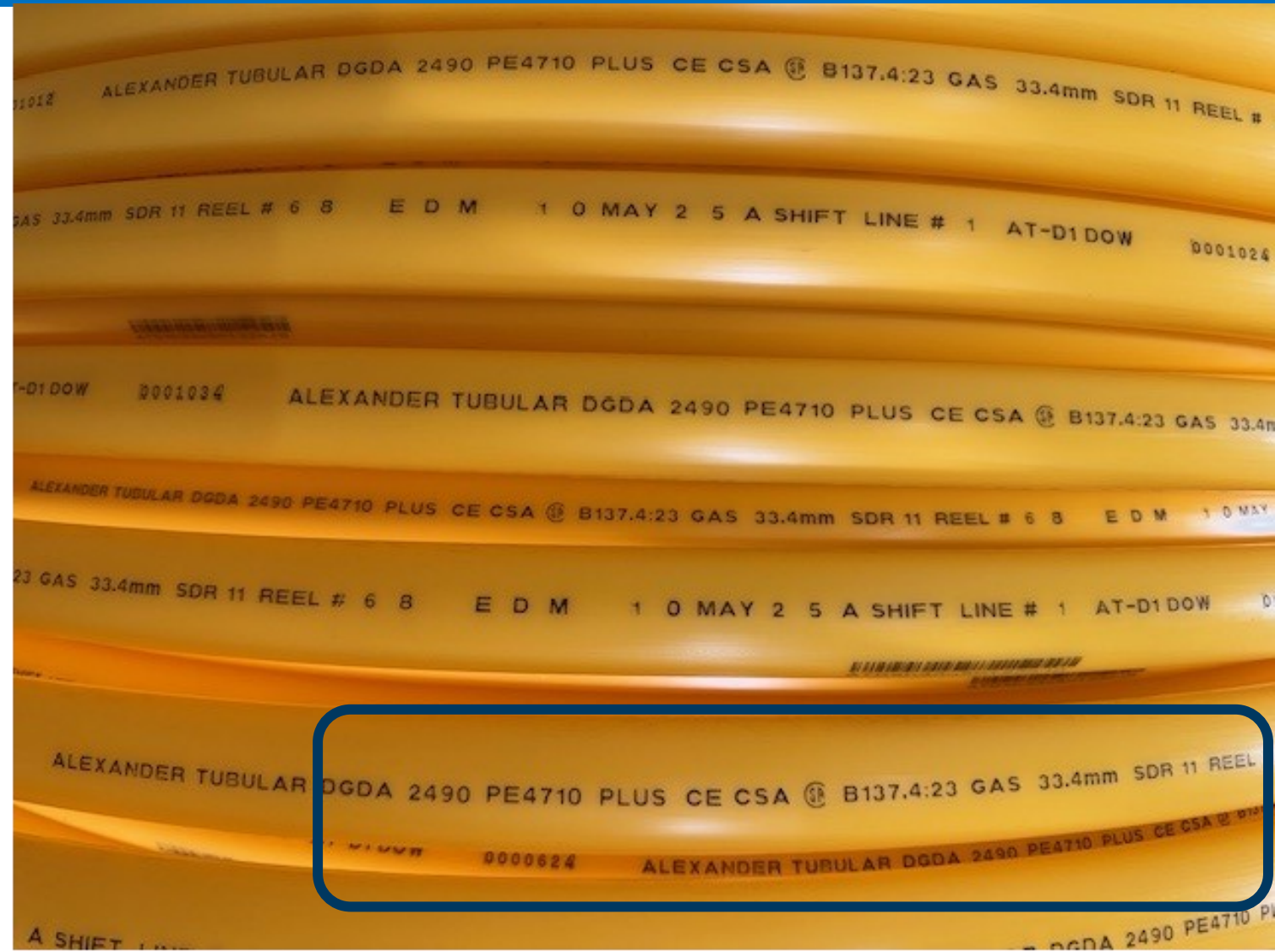

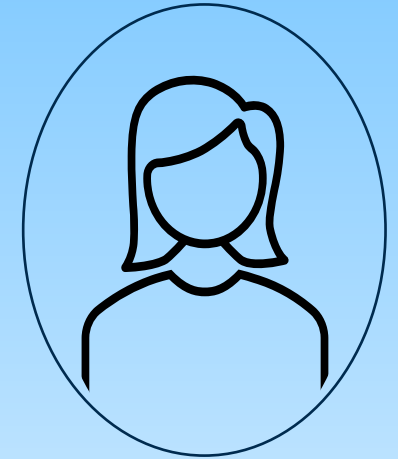

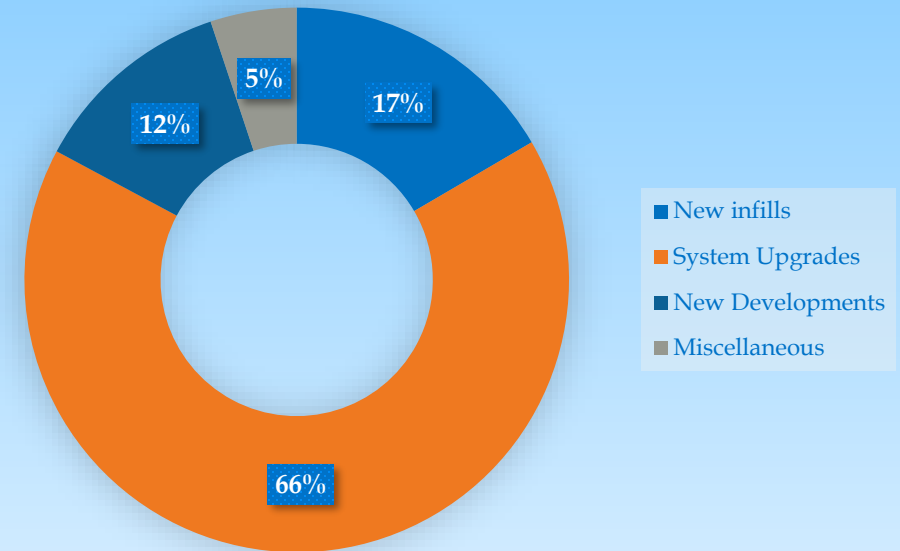


# 2025 Pipeline Construction Installations and Upgrades

## Installed 33 kms of PE pipe

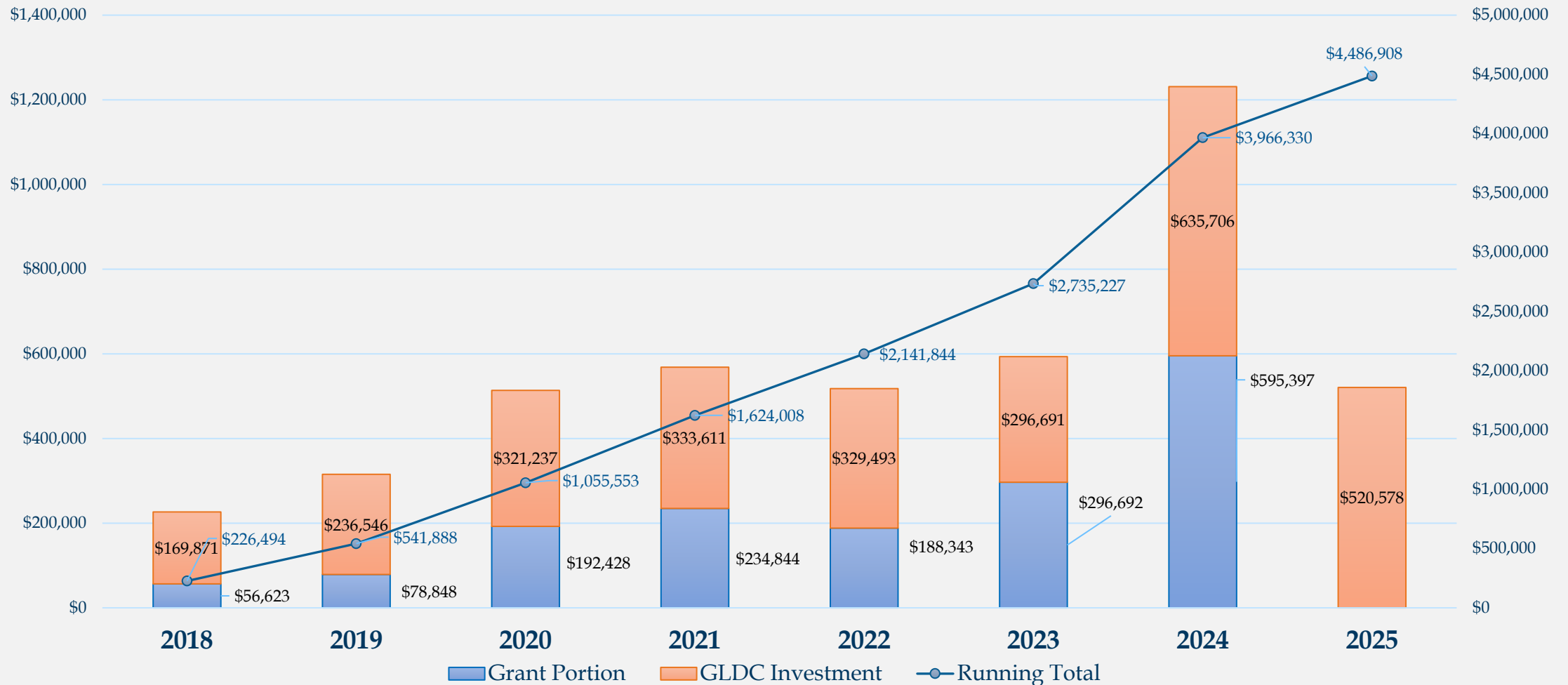
- 6 kms for 41 new services

# Tabled for clarification: Supplemental Bylaw # 7



## **SUPPLEMENTAL BY LAW # 7 - Definition of a member in good standing.**

“member in good standing” shall be a person who:

- a. Has paid the membership fee; and
- b. Has entered into a contract for the provision of natural gas service; and
- c. Has paid the required contribution to construction and extension of works cost, if any; and
- d. Has paid all accounts rendered by the Association when they became due; or
- e. Has not been declared by the Board, acting reasonably, to be a member not in good standing.
- f. In compliance with all policies, Standard and Supplemental By-Laws of the Association.

In the event that the Board has declared a member to be not in good standing pursuant to Section 2 (e), the Board shall give written notice to the member of its decision in the form attached as Schedule 1 to this Supplemental Bylaw.
